Guidance for the Extended Employment Sheltered Workshop Grant Program Awarded in Fiscal Year 2025

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INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE

On June 28, 2024, Governor Mike Parson signed House Bill 2 that appropriated \$2 million in grant funding in Fiscal Year 2025 (FY25) to support Extended Employment Sheltered Workshops (EESWs) across the state. The grant funding is in addition to the appropriated monthly state aid.

This guidance has been developed by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) to assist EESWs in accessing grant funds available for the program. The guidance contains the purpose of the grant funds, potential award amounts, allowable use of funds, program structure, timeline, documentation requirements for expenditures, and contact information.

The purpose of this grant is to provide financial support to EESWs for skills training, infrastructure, and equipment. See the following sections within the guidance document for more information.

GRANT APPLICATION AND AWARD

EXTENDED EMPLOYMENT SHELTERED WORKSHOP GRANT

The maximum grant award per EESW is based on the September 2024 employee working State Aid Data at the increments (up to and not to exceed) listed below. DESE reserves the right to reallocate any remaining funding that is not requested by EESWs after the application closes.

APPLICATION

EESWs applications open November 4, 2024, and are due on or before December 2, 2024. EESWs must submit applications to lisa.percival@dese.mo.gov. A sample of the application is included in Appendix A.

AWARD AND AMENDMENTS

Award notifications will be issued December 13, 2024. To request an amendment to an award, EESWs must resubmit a revised application.

EESWs may invoice for expenses with supporting documentation between January – June 2025. All final invoices are due June 5, 2025.

ALLOWABLE USE OF FUNDS

EESW Grant funds may only be utilized for the following purposes:

- Skills Training: A certified and approved program that helps certified employee of the EESW
 develop the skills, knowledge and competencies that result in an elevation of resistibility and
 possibility of higher compensation within the EESW.
- Infrastructure: Physical structures and facilities or components (e.g. buildings, roads, parking

lots) including improvements needed for the operation of an EESW.

• Equipment: Necessary items needed for the operation of an EESW that depreciate or have a recognized life span.

GRANT TIMELINE

EESWs will receive final payment by June 30, 2025.

EXPENDITURE AND OLBIGATION DATES

EESW Grant funds may be utilized for any purchase from July 1, 2024 through the end of the grant period. EESWs should follow all local procurement requirements.

INVOICE AND PAYMENT

INVOICE

EESW Grant funds are payable upon receipt of an invoice with supporting documentation. The EESW must use the grant invoice form. A sample invoice is shown in Appendix B. Supporting documentation may include a contract agreement, quote, purchase order, cashed check, credit card statement, etc. EESWs have until June 13, 2025, to complete purchases consistent with the approved application and submit a final invoice. Documentation of all expenditures must be maintained by the EESW and is subject to review through monitoring.

PAYMENT

Awarded EESWs will receive payment through June 30, 2025 for invoiced expenses. Payments are not part of the monthly state aid payment request.

DOCUMENTATION OF EXPENDITURES

EESWs s are required to keep documentation of expenditures (receipts, purchase orders, etc.) for monitoring purposes in accordance with record retention policies.
